The benefits of using beeswax candles - Beeswax candles are some of the oldest candles in history. Besides being all-natural, they possess several health benefits. They are reported to effectively reduce asthma, allergies, and hay fever symptoms. Like air purifiers, beeswax candles release negative ions that clean the air by neutralize the particles. They remove orders, pollens, pollutants, smoke, dust, viruses, plus other allergens and hazards in the air. Several other benefits of negative ions have been noted over the years from various studies. Here are a few:

- Increases sense of well-being and mental clarity. Often called a natural anti-depressant.
- Improves breathing rate, decreases blood pressure and relieves tension. There's some evidence that they may combat free radicals in your body too.
- Helps you sleep better by normalizing serotonin in the brain.
- Reduces headaches and other sickness.

Beware of other beeswax candles that say "Pure" Beeswax - In the U.S., the term "pure" on a label means only 51% of an ingredient (and that goes for food, too). Often, companies sell "pure" beeswax candles which contain a combination of 51% beeswax and 49% toxic paraffin. Look for the key phrase "100% Pure Beeswax" on candles.

100% pure beeswax candles cost more than paraffin candles, **that poison your home**. When you buy 100% pure beeswax candles, you are making a healthy investment. They're far superior in terms of health compared to paraffin candles. People who are sensitive to fragrances often prefer the light natural scent of beeswax to overly perfumed paraffin candles. The problem with paraffin wax lies in its origin. It's a by-product of petroleum refining and is actually made from the sludge at the bottom of crude oil barrels. As a result of the subsequent bleaching treatment from benzene or toluene, paraffin wax is filled with seven documented toxins, including two known carcinogens. On top of that, chemical colorings and fragrances are added to make them more appealing. Our eyes and noses may be fooled, but our bodies pay for all the toxins we breathe in when we burn those candles.

Beeswax candles are 100% bee-made, therefore 100% natural. This makes it a renewable resource too, unlike the petroleum products used to make paraffin candles. They also smell natural, since beeswax picks up the honey and nectar scents found in honeycomb. While burning, they emit the same light spectrum as the sun, which gives a more comforting ambiance than paraffin candles.

Beeswax has a high melting point (highest of any wax), meaning that your candles will last a lot longer than paraffin. They don't drip as much either, which leaves less mess. Burning paraffin candles also produces black soot that can stain walls and other interior surfaces. Beeswax candles burn cleaner and soot free.
